

## **Frequently asked questions**

- 1. How to reach IIT Hyderabad?
- A. Please refer to the guidelines attached with the document.
- 2. Will accommodation be provided at IIT Hyderabad?
- A. No accommodation will be provided at IIT Hyderabad. Candidates may look for hotels/lodges and other options in nearby villages of Kandi (3.3 km) and Isnapur (17 km), or town Sangareddy (7 km), or Hyderabad (nearest Patancheruvu is 24 km; Chandanagar, Miyapur, Lingampally are 1hr away).
- 3. Will TA/DA be provided for attending the written test?
- A. No.
- 4. What are the different eateries, restaurants available on IIT Hyderabad Campus?
- A. There is a wet canteen with different options (like lunch, sandwiches, maggi, snacks, tea, juice, milkshakes) available on campus near student hostels. Additionally, restaurants like Amritsarwala (North-Indian), Dakshin (South-Indian), Subway, Pizza hut, Beijing Bites, and other options are available in the Technology Research Park (TRP) within the IIT Hyderabad Campus.
- 5. Will the written exam be online or offline? te of Technology Hyderabad
- A. The written exam will be offline and conducted on 06th June 2022 from 1000-1200 hrs. No requests for conducting the written test in an online mode will be entertained.
- 6. Will the interview be online or offline?
- A. The interview will be offline. Only the candidates shortlisted following the written test are eligible for the interview. The schedule for the interview will be communicated after the examination on the MAE, IITH website (MAE | IIT Hyderabad). Please refer to this website for more details. The candidates are requested to only communicate to the Admissions team at me\_admissions@iith.ac.in for clarification.
- 7. What is the itinerary for 06th and 07th June 2022?
- A. Please refer to the document on the itinerary attached. Specific details regarding visit to teaching and research labs on 07th June 2022 will be communicated on the same day. Note that this visit is restricted to candidates who are shortlisted for the interview.
- 8. Can the dates on written test and interview be postponed on personal/medical grounds?
- A. The dates are final and cannot be changed. Candidates who do not appear for the written



test are not considered for subsequent rounds.

## 9. How do we choose the stream? Is this choice final?

- A. Depending on the ranking of applicants post-interview rounds, choice of stream will be given if the seats are available in the particular stream chosen. It may be noted that even for self-sponsored M.Tech there would be an upper cutoff for the number of students that can be admitted in a particular stream.
- 10. What is the format of the written test? What is the duration of the exam?

The exam is an objective type exam with multiple-choice questions and fill-in-the-blanks type questions. It includes a compulsory section on Maths and Aptitude comprising 20 questions. Further, the candidate is required to answer **any three of the other four sections** on Aero, IDM, MAD, and TFE. Each of these sections contains 13 questions. Overall, the candidate is required to answer 59 questions in 120 minutes. Each question carries one mark. There is a <u>negative marking</u> of 0.5 marks for wrong answers.

- 11. Is the choice of specialization decided based on the sections answered in the written examination?
  - A. It is expected that the candidate chooses the specialization, he/she is comfortable. However, it is not limited to the sections answered or marks obtained in a particular section attempted.
- 12. What are the documents required to be carried for the written examination and interviews?
  - A. The candidates are required to get a pen, calculator and any central govt. issued photo identity card. Without proper identification, the candidate will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
- 13. Where do candidates report on the day of written examination (06th June 2022)?
- A. Volunteers at admissions desk in the foyer of C-Block, IIT Hyderabad. If required, they will escalate it to concerned faculty.
- 14. Whom to contact for queries on 06th June and 07th June 2022?
- A. Volunteers at admissions desk in the foyer of C-Block, IIT Hyderabad. If required, they will escalate it to concerned faculty.
- 16. Whom to contact for queries before 06th June and after 07th June 2022?



- A. Drop a mail at <u>me\_admissions@iith.ac.in</u>. All queries regarding graduate admissions should be sent to me\_admission (me\_admissions@iith.ac.in); queries to personal email ids of faculties will not be entertained, and may lead to the rejection of the application
- 15. What is the syllabus for the written examination?
- A. UG syllabus. A sample question paper is uploaded at: <u>Sample-Admissions-Written-Test-for-MTech-&-PhD-Question-Paper.pdf (iith.ac.in)</u>
- 16. What is the syllabus for the interview?
- A. The interview will test the technical knowledge of the candidates. Under technical knowledge, we will try to assess if the candidate knows basic engineering mathematics and the basics of the specialization (Aero, IDM, MAD, TFE) opted by the candidate. There is no set syllabus for this.
- 17. What if the candidate reports late for the written test?
- A. The candidate will have to submit the written test at 1200 hrs sharp without any extension.
- 18. What if the candidate reports late for the interview? 23 000 2000 2000 200
- A. The candidate would have defaulted on the interview and will not be considered for further rounds.

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- 19. There is an error in the application form submitted to the IITH portal. Is any correction in application form possible?
- A. The candidate is advised to contact the me\_admissions test immediately. Minor modifications can be made with the permission of the DPGC and Head of the Department. Major modifications require approval from the Academic section, IITH.
